

# Color Poem

Color poems use your own imagination and your senses to describe different ideas about one color. You will use similes and metaphors. Similes compare two unlike things using the words "like" or "as". Metaphors are just like similes, but they do not use the words "like" or "as". They just say that one thing is something else.

*For example: "This classroom is a zoo."*
